

## Supply Lists for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Students

Supplies must be brought daily to each class. Please note that additional supplies may be added on the first day of school. Junior high students will receive an agenda on the first day of school.

General Supplies used in all classes: 8 #2 pencils with eraser. **Always used in math classes.**  
8 pens: 4 red and 4 black. No blue pens  
**Pens MUST be stick style. No click-style pens.**  
2 highlighters  
1 set of thin felt tip markers  
1 box (24 in all) of colored pencils  
1 small portable pencil sharpener  
1 6 in ruler  
1 pair of scissors  
1 hole punch  
1 large glue stick  
1 noiseless container/pouch for supplies  
3 packages of college loose-leaf binder paper  
1 backpack

In addition to the above general supplies, some classes require specific items.

Computer: Flash drive (with name on the case)  
1 Pocket folder dedicated to computer handouts.

Social Studies: 1-2 spiral college ruled notebook(s) (60 pages minimum)  
1 3 prong 2 pocket folder for maps (7<sup>th</sup> grade only)

Spanish: Spanish-English Dictionary (preferably Webster's)  
Composition book dedicated to Spanish notes  
1 package (100) plain 3" x 5" index cards  
¾" binder for vocabulary sheets  
1 package of A to Z divider tabs  
50 back to back copies of vocabulary sheet (see website)  
¾" binder with 10 clear sheet protectors for assignments

Religion: 1-2 spiral college ruled notebook(s) (60 pgs minimum)  
1 *New American Bible*, St. Joseph Edition (stays in locker)  
(Purchased in 5<sup>th</sup> grade, must replace if lost or new to school)  
1 3 prong 2 pocket folder for journal  
1 composition book  
1 pocket folder dedicated to religion papers

English and Lit: **8<sup>th</sup> Eng and Lit, 7<sup>th</sup> grade Eng**  
1-inch binder with a pocket in cover for papers  
Loose-leaf binder paper (no other paper allowed)  
All books listed under required reading for your grade level. (see below)  
**7<sup>th</sup> grade Literature only**  
1 sturdy pocket folder dedicated to literature only  
1 college ruled (60 pages minimum) bound notebook (no spirals)  
All books listed under required reading. (see below)

Science: 1 bound composition notebooks  
1 sturdy pocket folder dedicated to science handouts  
Graph paper (4 squares/inch) for lab reports  
Optional 6 pair of vinyl or latex gloves for dissection (7<sup>th</sup> grade only)  
1 scientific calculator (also used in math)

Math:  
(Sr. Maria) 1 spiral college ruled (60 pages minimum) notebook  
1 scientific calculator (also used in science)  
1 package of loose-leaf binder paper dedicated to math  
Graph paper (4 squares/inch)

Math:  
(Mrs. Kustura) 1 compass (7<sup>th</sup> grade only)  
1 protractor (7<sup>th</sup> grade only)  
1 scientific calculator (7<sup>th</sup> grade Trig unit only, also used in science)  
2 graph paper composition books, dedicated to math  
Graph paper (4 squares/inch) for all work. (Paper must not be ripped from a spiral notebook.) You will use 3-4 packages during the year.  
1- 1 ½ inch binder with 5 divider tabs, dedicated to math only
